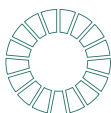


Highlights from the 2023 Development Co-operation Peer Review of the Czech Republic

THE CZECH REPUBLIC'S STRENGTHS...

A long term strategy aligned with SDGs



A 2018-2030 strategy aligned with the 2030 Agenda ensures predictability and provides for flexibility

Strong support to human rights anchored in the Czech Republic's history



Supports human rights activists locally and speaks on their behalf in international fora

Co-ordination with the European Union increases influence



The Czech Republic is now part of 15 Team Europe Initiatives (TEIs) and implements 5 delegated co-operation projects

Strategic evaluations are used to improve development co-operation



The Czech Republic has used findings from evaluations to redesign programmes (e.g. scholarships)

...AND AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

Rethink the institutional set-up with empowered country presence



Sustain increase in ODA volume



Explicitly address poverty and/or inequality in programming and integrate cross-cutting issues



Adjust private sector instruments to increase local private sector participation and development impact



PROGRESS SINCE THE PREVIOUS PEER REVIEW

The Czech Republic has partially or fully implemented **15** of the **16** recommendations from its review in 2016. **4** fully implemented; **11** partially implemented; **1** not implemented.

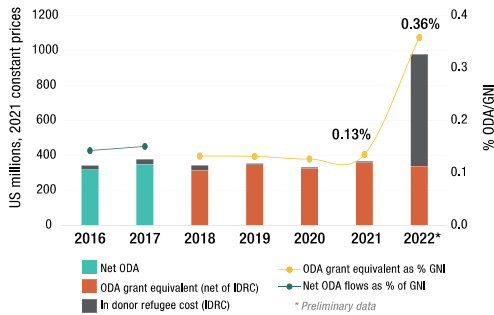

Infographic: The Czech Republic's development co-operation at a glance

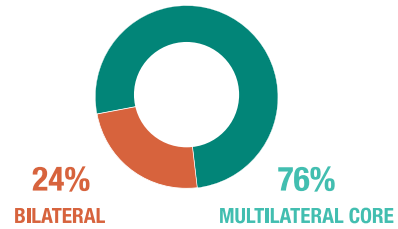

DUE TO SUPPORT TO UKRAINE AND UKRAINAIN REFUGEES, THE CZECH REPUBLIC EXCEEDED ITS COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE 0.33% OF GROSS NATIONAL INCOME (GNI) AS ODA IN 2022



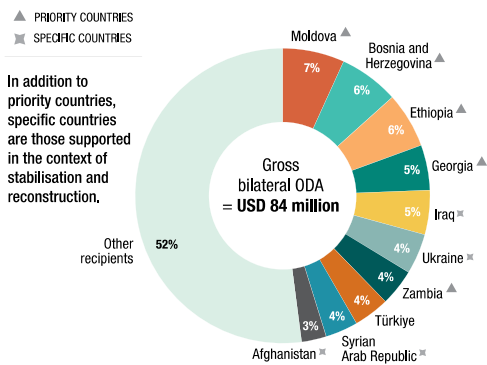
IN 2021, MOST OF CZECH ODA WAS PROVIDED MULTILATERALLY

2021, Current prices



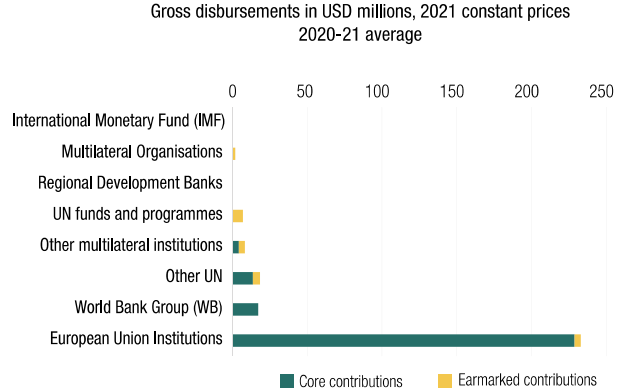

2020-21 average



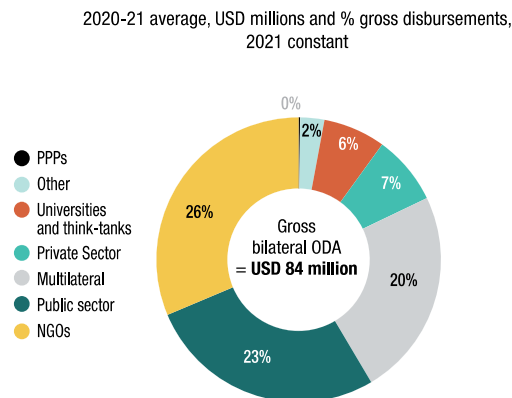
THE EU IS BY FAR THE MOST IMPORTANT RECIPIENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC'S MULTILATERAL ODA
